Your specific Sunday to attend in-person will be determined alphabetically, as we have designated seating in the sanctuary to accomplish social distancing and limit capacity to 25% per service.

Sunday, **November 1** – members with last names **A-D** are invited to attend
Sunday, **November 8** – members with last names **E-I** are invited to attend
Sunday, **November 15** – members with last names **J-P** are invited to attend
Sunday, **November 22** – members with last names **Q-Z** are invited to attend
Sunday, **November 29** – Virtual Communion & all members worship live online from home

This is very exciting for all of us! We have all missed each other so desperately during this season of physical separation. During November, we will be watching to see how this works and also keeping a close eye on the Coronavirus to make decisions about future in-person services.

Please allow me to share some protocols and specifics about how this will work:

1. **MASKS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES ON THE PROPERTY** and everyone attending in person will have their temperature checked at the door.
2. Everyone attending should respect other members' space without hugging, hand shaking, touching, or crowding one another.
3. Everyone attending will follow the seating guidelines for maintaining social distancing.
4. When service is over, please exit the sanctuary without gathering in groups.
5. Doors will open at 9:30 am and seating will take place between 9:30-9:55 am. Also, please note there will be specific entry/exit doors and other posted instructions.

Know When To Stay Home FAQ:

- What if I am considered “High-Risk”?

If you or someone in your family or you care for is considered “high-risk” for severe illness, we encourage you to continue worshipping with us online and from home.

- What if I am Feeling Sick?

Stay home when you are sick! If you or someone in your family or you care for feels unwell or has experienced fever, cough or shortness or breath in the last 14 days, we encourage you to continue worshipping with us online and from home. You should not attend any public gatherings if in the last 14 days you have tested positive, been experiencing symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath), or have a known exposure to COVID-19.
